ALL FOR GEO-HERITAGE



The Society partnered with the Society of Earth Scientists, India, Geoclub, Geological Survey of India, Southern Region to organize the "Save our Geo-heritage Run" on Necklace Road on 21 July. The Honorable Minister of State, Home Affairs Government of India Shri G.Kishan Reddy flagged off the Run and also spoke about saving the rocks of Telangana. Similar events were held at Chandigarh, Udaipur, Lucknow and Dehradun. The Press echo was good with the coverage in the electronic media and articles in the Times of India, Hans India, Andhra Jyothi and other vernacular papers.

The Run was followed by a brain storming session on "Conservation of Geoheritage: Current Scenario and Future Action Plan" at Indian National Science Academy (INSA), New Delhi in August. The Society of Earth Scientists (SES) with the Indian National Committee for IUGS-INQUA and INSA presented a Status Paper and Draft Legislation before technocrats, lawmakers, UNESCO and Government officials at New Delhi to enact a Law for the conservation of our Geoheritage. The core group proposed that Geoheritage should be included in the M.Sc.syllabus, a day should be declared National/International Geoheritage Day and that Universities need to enhance awareness about the importance of geological monuments. The technical session presented by Dr. Satish C. Tripathi, General Secretary, SES was on "Geoheritage and Geoparks: Indian and International Scenario."

The Earth Scientists August 2019 Newsletter carried the Society's feature "Saving the Secular Hillock of Khajjaguda." The endangered Heritage site will hopefully get visibility and gain support from it's 600 odd member scientists spread across the country. 
