



ONE GENEROUS HILL, THREE SACRED SHRINES - FAKHRUDDINGUTTA

Drive out towards Gachibowli and one's vision is assaulted by high-rise buildings jostling with each other for vertical space. When you look a little further you see the serene backdrop of the Khajaguda Hillock also known as Fakhruddingutta with its casually strewn boulders seemingly caught in a time warp. While people now know it as Lanco Hills this hillock and the three shrines located have a history and are held dear among its respective followers.

The highest point of the rock sheet has the 650 year old tomb of Saint Hazrat Baba Fakhruddin Aulia. Believed to be the spiritual mentor of Hasan Gangu, Founder of the Bahmani Kingdom he was buried here in 1353 AD. Though modest in construction the modernized tomb stands in a grand landscape. Pilgrims flock here on Fridays and holidays. The annual Urs brings thousands of devotees both Muslims and Hindus to the Dargah.

The Meher Baba Cave close to the Dargah is considered as one of the most significant pilgrim sites among. Meher Baba followers. It was in this cave that Meher Baba carried out what he called "Manonash" or "annihilation of the mind "in 1951. Pilgrims are drawn here from the world over. Meetings are held on second Saturdays, an annual celebration happens in the third week of October.

The Anantha Padmanabha Swamy Temple hidden among trees and boulders down in the hills is like a well kept secret. It has Vishnu in the lying down pose, a small Hanuman and a stone Stamba. Supposedly 600 years old, built during the Akkanna-Madanna period, both the devout and the curious find their way here. Off late daily 'puja' is being performed with a large celebration coming up in February.

Not forgetting that the generous hill is also a mecca for rock climbers. This year, Fakrhruddingutta was the venue for the All India Rock Climbing Championship organised by the GHAC held on December 21 st. It drew national and international participants. The Society has been pursuing the matter of a Rock Park in the hill with the Tourism Department for many years.

More reasons than one why we should make sure that our pet rock site Fakhruddingutta is preserved for all time!
